FREE BREAKFAST AND LUNCH FOR ALL STUDENTS – REVISED TIMES

The Food Service Department will be providing **FREE** breakfasts and lunches for all children up to the age of 18 and students with disabilities, ages 18-26, with an active IEP, regardless of whether they are a Richmond student or not.

The District will have three buses that will travel to various bus stops throughout the District on Mondays, Wednesdays, and Fridays. On Mondays, students will receive a lunch for Monday and Tuesday as well as a breakfast for Tuesday and Wednesday. On Wednesdays, students will receive a lunch for Wednesday and Thursday, as well as a breakfast for Thursday and Friday. On Fridays, students will receive a lunch for Friday and a breakfast for Monday. Either, children may go to one of the pre-determined bus stops and pick up a couple of days' worth of breakfast and lunch from the staff on the bus or parents may pick up on behalf of their child(ren). Below you will find the bus routes, stops, and approximate times for **FREE** breakfast & lunch drop-offs.

While the Governor's Executive Order, 2020-21 Stay Home Stay Safe, was issued on Monday, March 23rd and called for the shutdown of all non-essential operations, the delivery of meals is considered an essential function of the government and will continue through Friday, April 3rd (Spring Break April 6th – 10th). At that time the District will re-evaluating the program and resources needed for meal preparation and deliver, should the mandated school shutdown continue.

TO PROTECT THE WORKERS, VOLUNTEERS, STUDENTS, AND FAMILIES involved in the food distribution, Food Service Employees and volunteer will remain on the bus during deliveries. Volunteers will place the packaged meals on the steps of the bus for students and parents to pick up, thus minimizing person-to-person contact. While waiting for the bus to arrive and when picking up the food packages, please remember to follow social distancing guidelines.
